Beginning the new year and a new decade we can look forward to many new classes, events and worship services that will focus on *Loving Jesus and Loving Like Jesus*.

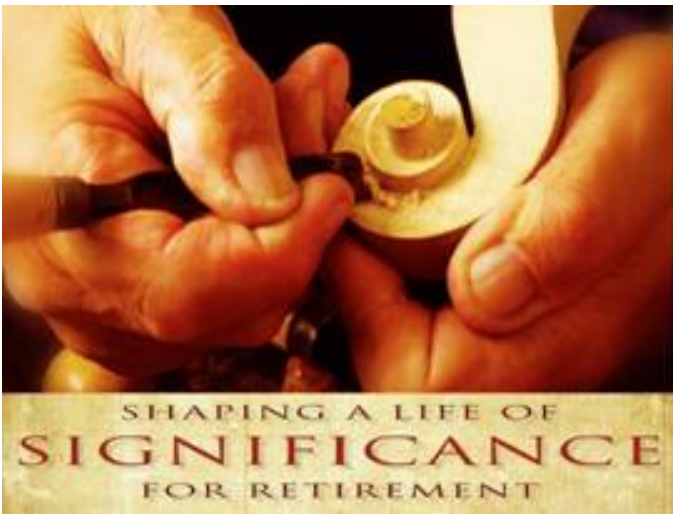
