




& Blessing of the Backpacks AUGUST 10. ONE SERVICE. 10AM

Welcome to The Chef's Table!

This space is where Chef Ian gives away all the little tricks of the trade that set one apart from the average home cook...

These are the techniques and practices that those in the finest restaurants around utilize on a daily basis and the good news is, they aren't that hard!

'When you give a feast, invite the poor, the crippled, the lame, the blind.' -Luke 14:13

Salt Your Meat! Before grilling beef, pork or chicken, salt the meat on both sides and let it rest in the refrigerator for 2 hours. This is called 'dry-brining' and denatures (breaks-down) the tight protein strands to allow for a more tender piece of meat. Table salt is just one atom of sodium and one of chlorine (NaCl) so it is the only molecule simple enough to penetrate the meat entirely. Marinades only work because of their salt content so do what chefs do... buy good meat, salt and rest

'Craft' Instead of 'Kraft' Add a few tablespoons of good olive oil and a few shaves of citrus zest to a cup of any mayonnaise-based dressing such as one for coleslaw or chicken salad. This adds a richness and brightness while smoothing out the dressing.

it, and keep it simple!

Turn Up the Brightness! Acid is equally important as salt and pepper to every dish. Whether it be a good vinegar (sherry, balsamic, apple cider...) or a squeeze of fresh citrus juice, finishing a dish with a touch of acidity will bring every other flavor to another level.

Salt is important as a flavor catalyst in that it makes an ingredient taste more like itself. **Acid** is it's sidekick as it elevates combinations of flavors like a conductor to a symphony!

Her VBS Bible Story sets are legendary to generations of children and tailored to each summer's theme. She leads different Bible studies throughout the school year including "How to Use Your Bible" and "The Armor of God".

Her weekly Sing and Ring ensemble performs several times a year with song, handbells, percussion and puppets. Ms. Vicki also teaches Sunday School each week with lessons that speak to children and a message that they can take with them.


THE MAN FROM ASSISI
