Position Purpose and Description: The role of the Student Ministries Director is to oversee the development and implementation of ministries with youth from 6th – 12th grades.

Work Schedule: Part-time employment performing from 20 to less than 30 actual scheduled work hours per week. Preapproval authorization to be scheduled and to work actual hours in excess of this weekly work hour limitation is required to be obtained by the employee from the employee's supervisor and the GBUMC Administrator in accordance with Gulf Breeze United Methodist Church (GBUMC) employee policies.

FLSA Classification: Non-exempt, hourly wages.

Reports to Supervisor: Senior Pastor

Requirements:

- Profess Christianity
- Support the mission and policies of Gulf Breeze United Methodist Church.
- Adhere to all policies in the Landrum Handbook.
- Demonstrate an agreeable, positive attitude.
- An undergraduate degree, preferably in education or religious studies.
- Experience working with church staff is preferred.
- Demonstrate the ability to develop and implement youth ministry programming successfully.
- Be proficient in communication skills, team building, problem-solving, and recruiting volunteers.

Primary Duties and Responsibilities:

- Develop, assess, and modify curriculum to meet the needs of students for Sunday school and youth ministry.
- Assist the Director of Connectional Ministries in overseeing Safe Sanctuary policies.
- Oversee budgeted areas related to youth.
- Work with the Director of Connectional Ministries and the Children's Ministry Director to recruit, train, and equip volunteers to work with children and youth.

- Offer strategies to volunteers to help with classroom management and student behavior problems.
- Assist in developing literature and advertisements to promote ministries.
- Ensure that the overall appearance and safety of the youth facility and equipment are maintained and in good repair.
- Plan and execute weekly youth fellowship times and other special youth events throughout the year such as retreats, outings, and mission trips.
- Attend weekly staff meetings.
- Be available to speak to promote the student ministries of Gulf Breeze United Methodist Church.
- As reasonable, be present in the community, especially at the schools for special events such as concerts, sports, etc.
- Other duties assigned by Senior Pastor
