This year Gulf Breeze United Methodist Church celebrated its 70th anniversary. It's been an exciting year to watch how God is on the move through the mission and ministry of GBUMC. It's even more exciting to imagine what God has in store for us in 2026!

During the month of October, our congregation will be focusing on stewardship. This year's stewardship focus is called - Overflow: Living Generously from a Heart Full of God's Grace. When God's blessings overflow from our lives, they create ripples that reach farther than we can see. This four-week series invites us to discover how God's abundance moves through us - blessing others, refreshing weary hearts, and multiplying into "every good work" that transforms lives and communities for Jesus Christ.

We invite you to participate in the stewardship focus on the Sunday mornings of October 5, 12, 19, and 26. Together, we will focus on Paul's words to the church at Corinth -"And God is able to bless you abundantly, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will overflow in every good work." (2 Corinthians 9:8) Each Sunday's worship will highlight how God generosity is overflowing in our lives and how we are called to respond to it

From weekly challenges and stories, we will consider what it means for us to be part of this amazing ministry that is transforming lives for Jesus Christ.

Sunday, October 26, will be "Promise Sunday." We ask that you prayerfully consider filling out a 2025-26 Promise Card in a manner appropriate for you or your family. We invite you to bring your Promise Card with you to worship on Promise Sunday as we ask God to bless the work of ministry that is to be continued through GBUMC. Since it's inception in 2000, Gulf Breeze United Methodist Church has aided Interfaith Ministries in its assistance of the under-resourced, under-served citizens of our community with food, housing, utilities, clothing and other emergent needs.

VOLUNTEE Spotlight

BUILDINGS & GROUNDS

Two years ago Al Garza stepped up to share his time and talents, serving behind the scenes with Building and Ground Maintenance.

Al has served as project manager to bring new, safer fencing to the Children's Place Playground and a complete renovation to the Lecture Hall. He was instrumental in moving the data base server from the mechanical room to its new location in the Lecture Hall.

Yet, he jumps into the small jobs with the same dedication; coordinating workers or doing it himself. He procured a lift for the Sanctuary so that much needed sound and lighting updates could be completed.





When there was need for a new stable for our outdoor nativity, Al built it. When the irrigation system at the Children's Building needed repair, Al fixed it. When old lighting fixtures needed upgrading, Al replaced them. He's changed out toilets, repaired faucets and water lines, replaced a garbage disposal, and spent countless hours painting the hallways, classrooms, and pastor's offices.

You can usually find Al somewhere covered in paint, on top of a ladder or outside with a saw or mower. When you see him, take a minute to stop and thank Al: our volunteer of the month.

Annual Charge Conference

The charge conference is the basic governing body of each United Methodist local church and is composed of all members of the church council. All members of the charge conference must be members of the local church and the charge conference must meet at least once per year. The charge conference directs the work of the church and gives general oversight to the church council, reviews and evaluates the mission and ministry of the church, sets salaries for the pastor and staff, elects the members of the church council, and recommends candidates for ordained ministry.

Our annual charge conference will be Monday, October 27 at 6pm in the Sanctuary. All church leaders are encouraged to attend. Reception in the Reception Hall to follow.
