

A Message from Erik The Gift of Unity



Dear Church,

This fall, like many of you, I'll be caught up in the excitement of football season. At every game, each player brings with them their own set of skills in order to compete. But here's the truth: no quarterback wins the game without a line to protect him, no running back gets far without good blocking, and no defense succeeds unless everyone plays their part. A single star can shine, but a team wins the game.

That's the power of unity.

Scripture says it this way in Ecclesiastes 4:9–10: "Two are better than one, because they have a good reward for their toil. For if they fall, one will lift up the other."

Jesus understood this better than anyone. When He began His ministry, He could have chosen to walk alone. But instead, He called twelve disciples—fishermen, tax collectors, ordinary men—to walk beside Him, learn from Him, and share in His mission

to walk beside Him, learn from Him, and share in His mission. Together, this small band carried the Good News that changed the world. Even after His resurrection, Jesus sent His followers out two by two (Mark 6:7), knowing that together they would be stronger, braver, and more faithful.

The Apostle Paul reminds us that the Church is like a body: "Now you are the body of Christ, and individually members of it" (1 Corinthians 12:27). Each of us has a different role, but when we bring those various roles together, the whole body thrives.

Christian unity is not just about being on the same team-it's about letting Christ bring us together for a purpose far greater than just ourselves. Just as Jesus multiplied the loaves and fishes, God multiplies what we bring when we offer it together.

So, the next time you watch a game, or read the Gospels, or gather in worship, remember this: we are at our best when we walk side by side in the Spirit. That's the gift of unity—when Christ binds us together for something far greater than we could ever accomplish alone.


