## 3's Potty Trained Policy

In order to comply with health code regulations for our facility all children registered in the 3's program MUST be completely potty trained. The well-being of our children is a top priority. It is because of this that we need to follow this policy. We understand that children will have accidents at this age and we will attend to those situations. The following list will help parents to understand the definition of being potty trained for the three year old program.

**A potty trained child is a child who can do the following:**

- 1) TELL the adult they have to go potty BEFORE they have to go. They must be able to say the words "I have to go potty" BEFORE they have to go.
- 2) They need to be able to pull down their underwear and pants and get them back up with minimal assistance.
- 3) The child should be in underwear and not a pull up.
- 3) Be able to try to wipe themselves after using the toilet.
- 4) Be able to get off the potty by themselves.
- 5) Be able to wash and dry hands.
- 6) They need to be able to go through a school week without having daily accidents.
